We are always in need of people who can help keep our fridge stocked.

Our fridge is located at the back corner of Duncan Hall, at the corner of Ross Ave. and Kensington Rd.



What to give:

- ✓ Fresh fruit and vegetables
- ✓ Milk, cheese, butter, yogurt (including lactose-free options)
- ✓ Eggs (1/2 cartons)
- ✓ Nut butters
- ✓ Jam
- ✓ Tuna
- ✓ Breads + Pastries (with packaging)
- ✓ Pantry items (rice, pasta, canned food, boxed soups, etc.)

What not to give:

- ✗ ANY meat, raw or otherwise
- ✗ Anything frozen
- ✗ Alcoholic beverages
- ✗ Expired items
- ✗ Anything you wouldn't feed your family
